**Notification of Phishing Email & Fraudulent Website**

**Hong Kong, 3 June 2010** – Shanghai Commercial Bank (the “Bank”) would like to alert all customers and the public that the Bank has no affiliation with the recent phishing emails requesting email receivers to login to a provided fraudulent website at <http://59.252.20.1/sh/onl/>. The phishing email links to a webpage that looks similar to the Bank’s i-Banking login page.

Customers and the public are strongly advised not to click on any URL or hyperlink embedded in an email accessing directly to the Bank’s services or information. Please take note that all of the Bank’s internet banking services can only be accessed through the official homepage located at [www.shacombank.com.hk](http://www.shacombank.com.hk).

The Bank has reported the case to the Police and the Hong Kong Monetary Authority, and will take necessary actions to protect the interests of the customers, the public and the Bank.
